The Hour of Code is returning to PRES! We are preparing for the official Hour of Code which begins on Monday, December 3rd.

During technology classes, all students in grades K-5 will participate in coding activities. Students will rotate between stations with online tutorials and games, coding robots, as well as unplugged programming activities. These activities introduce students to basic computer programming skills and help to develop problem-solving skills, algorithmic thinking, pattern recognition, and persistence.
